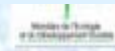
LEGAL FRAMEWORK

Existing Legal Framework

- All ground water and all surface water and wastewater resources are vested to the state.
- The Government has the power to construct waterworks and sell water at a price fixed by the Government and the Parliament.
- The water rights are protected and riparian rights are given to those who can prove that they own such rights.
- The Laws give the right to private individuals to sink or construct wells or drill boreholes, for ground water abstraction, after getting a permit from the District Officer.
- The Laws give the right to individuals to form Irrigation Divisions or Associations to construct irrigation works.

La loi sur l'eau repose sur un certain nombre de principes de base qui découlent des objectifs cités ci-dessus :

- la domanialité publique des eaux : d'après ce principe, posé par les dahirs de 1914 et 1919, toutes les eaux font partie du domaine public à l'exception des droits acquis et reconnus. Cependant, la nécessité d'une valorisation maximale des ressources en eau imposée par leur rareté a fait que la loi a apporté une limite à ces droits de telle sorte que les propriétaires de droits sur les eaux seulement ou sur des eaux qu'ils n'utilisent qu'en partie seulement pour leurs fonds ne peuvent les céder qu'aux propriétaires de fonds agricoles,
- la mise au point d'une planification de l'aménagement et de la répartition des ressources en eau basée sur une large concertation entre les usagers et les pouvoirs publics,
- la protection de la santé de l'homme par la réglementation de l'exploitation, de la distribution et de la vente des eaux à usage alimentaire,
- la réglementation des activités susceptibles de polluer les ressources en eau,
- la répartition rationnelle des ressources en eau en période de sécheresse pour atténuer les effets de la pénurie,
- une plus grande revalorisation agricole grâce à l'amélioration des conditions d'aménagement et d'utilisation des eaux à usage agricole,
- la prévision de sanctions et la création d'une police des eaux pour réprimer toute exploitation illicite de l'eau ou tout acte susceptible d'altérer sa qualité.

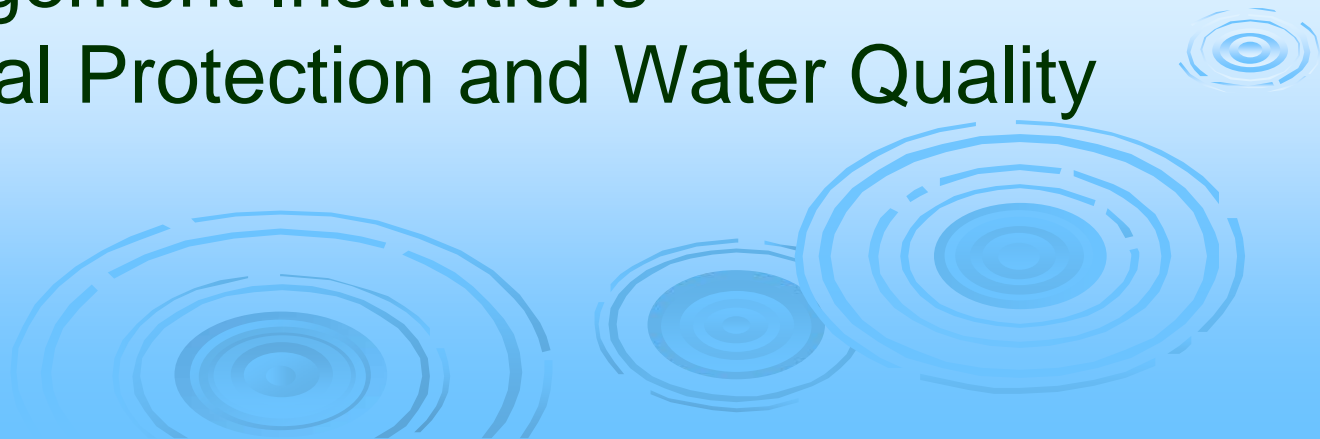

Water Rights

Article 1 of the [Water Law](#) expresses the underlying philosophy of Israel's approach to its water resources by providing that:

"The water resources of the State are public property; they are subject to the control of the State and are destined for the requirements of its inhabitants and for the development of the country".

In Israel there is neither private nor state ownership of water resources. All water resources belong to the public. The State controls the water resources of the land as a trustee .The water resources are held for the benefit of the inhabitants of the land and are to be used for its development .

Legal Tools for the Management of Scarce Water Resources

The shortage requires a mechanism to allocate the short supply while preserving the water resources .

...

The Water Law requires a permit for all water uses.

...

Hence, the Water Commissioner controls, through an elaborate licensing mechanism, both the quantity that may be drawn from each water resource as well as the amount that may be consumed .

The existing licensing system allows the Water Commissioner to control water use in areas or times of shortage.
