To create <u>a tool for cooperation</u> between the European and Mediterranean countries whose aim is to:


- Facilitate access to the existing information on knowhow;

 Austria, Belgium, Cyprus, France, Greece, Italy,
 Luxembourg, Malta, Portugal, Spain
- Mediterranean partners: 10 countries

 10 NFP created and 8 active websites
 Algeria, Egypt, Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, Morocco,
 Palestine, Syria, Tunisia, Turkey





Role of EMWIS focal points for each country

- >The water information portal for the country
- The window on the country know-how in the water sector
- >A major tool for building new collaborations
- >A node of the Euro-Med system





Milestones

- > Dec. 1997 Decision of Euro-Med water directors to implement EMWIS
- > July 1998 Creation of the EEIG EMWIS TU
- **▶** July 1999 EC grant signature for Phase 1 with co-funding from FR, IT, SP
- ➤ Nov. 1999 T.U. operational



- > Nov. 2001 Phase 2 strategic plan approved by Euro-Med water directors
- **Dec. 2002 End of phase 1**
- ➤ Dec. 2003 EC grant signature for Phase 2 (Dec. 2003 Nov. 2006) with co-funding from FR, IT, SP
