This is the third announcement of the International Conference on "The Environment: Survival and Sustainability" which will take place on 19-24 February 2007, at the Near East University in Northern Cyprus. The conference language is English.

I would like to bring to your attention the fact that the Organizing Committee has decided to grant a final chance to those who missed the deadlines. It will be sufficient to submit a full paper/poster by 15th October 2006 even if you have not submitted an abstract by now.

I would also urge you to make your registration and accommodation arrangements as soon as possible even if you are only attending as a member of the audience.

I have the pleasure to confirm that three Nobel Laureates will be making keynote speeches at the Conference Plenary Sessions. A further one hundred plus keynote speeches will be delivered by the prominent members of the Scientific Committee. The Scientific Committee has, so far, approved more than one thousand abstracts from around 90 countries. Leading scientific journals and publishers such as Advanced Knowledge International, Journal of Environmental Science and Health, and Journal of Toxicology and Environmental Health, Journal of Toxicology and Environmental Chemistry, Environmental Science Unit of Springer have offered to publish the Conference Proceedings.

The social activities organized during the Conference will provide you with the opportunity to experience the social, cultural, historical and natural wealth of the Island.
